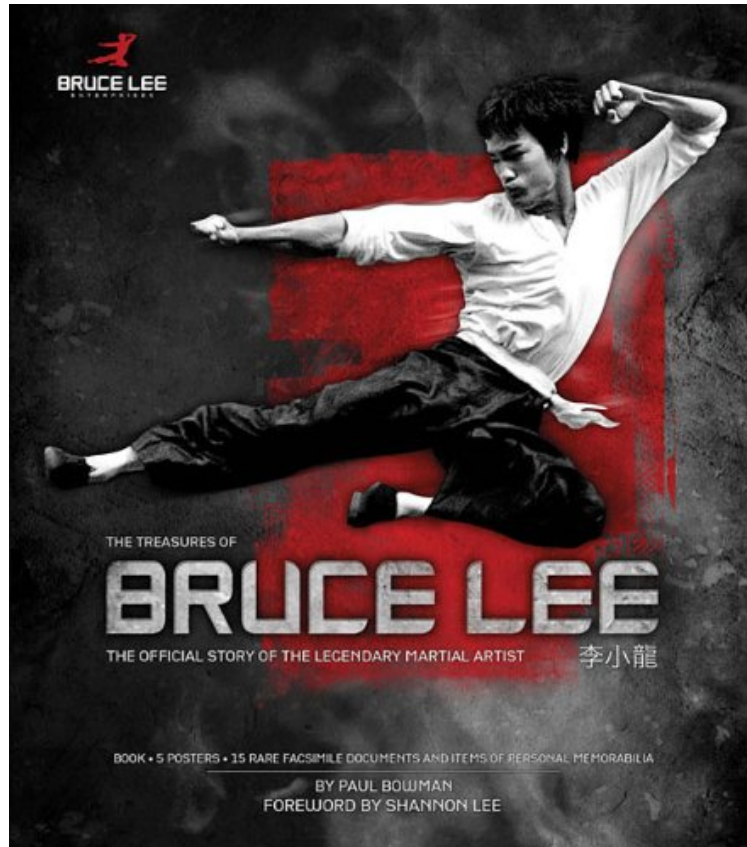

There are a few Bruce Lee books out there but most of them are bland so to say. This book however, is the book I've been waiting for, for 10 years. Although it's only 96 pages long, this book chronicles his life from a child movie star, to his time spent filming Enter the Dragon and Green Hornet, all the way to his untimely death. Each page is filled with huge, high def photographs, and some of them I've never even seen before. But the real treat of this book are the little "treasures" hidden in the book. There are TONS of personal items of Bruce that are authentically replicated. Inside you'll find a couple of his movie posters. You'll find a letter that Boxer Jack Dempsey had written to Bruce. You'll also find a Jeet Kune Do student card. My personal favorite is the replication of his notebook which had his own notes and drawings in it.
