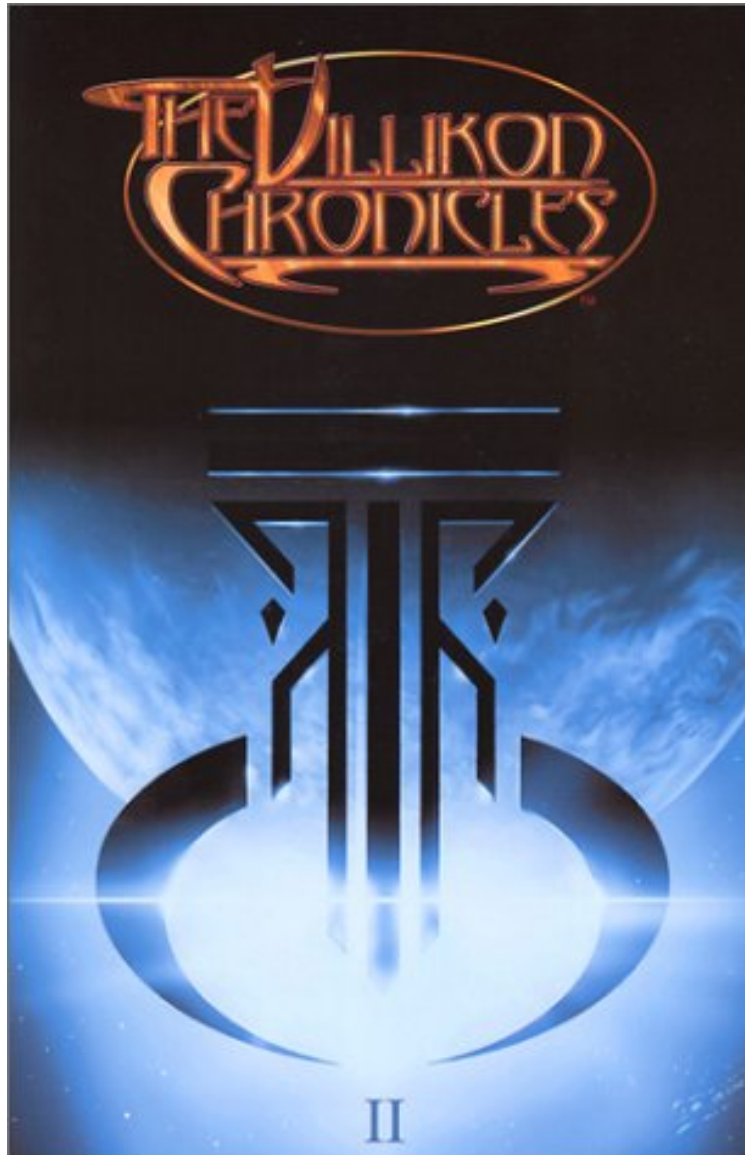

Existing in a villainous society with no hope for escape, Villikon searches for a place to call home.
