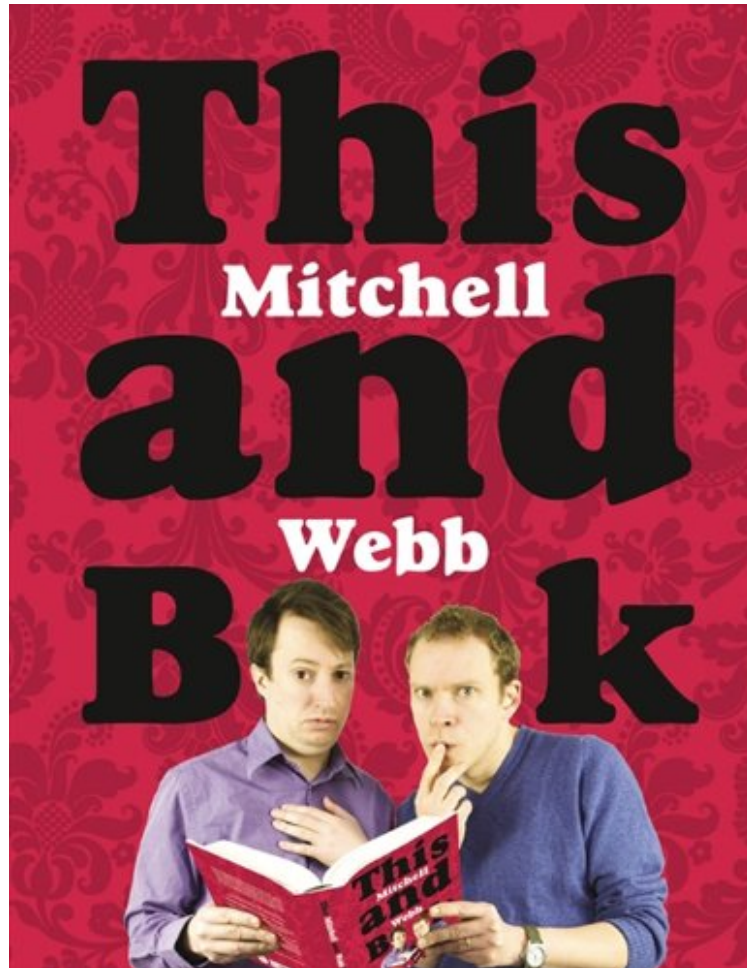

There is very little writing, but there is a boatload of random... uh... stuff? The duo takes over writing articles and in-between the 2 page articles (which are exceptionally written) is a whole lot of useless "trying to be funny" filler. Some stuff ties in with the show (the snooker player biographies), but the other stuff is just... abysmal.
