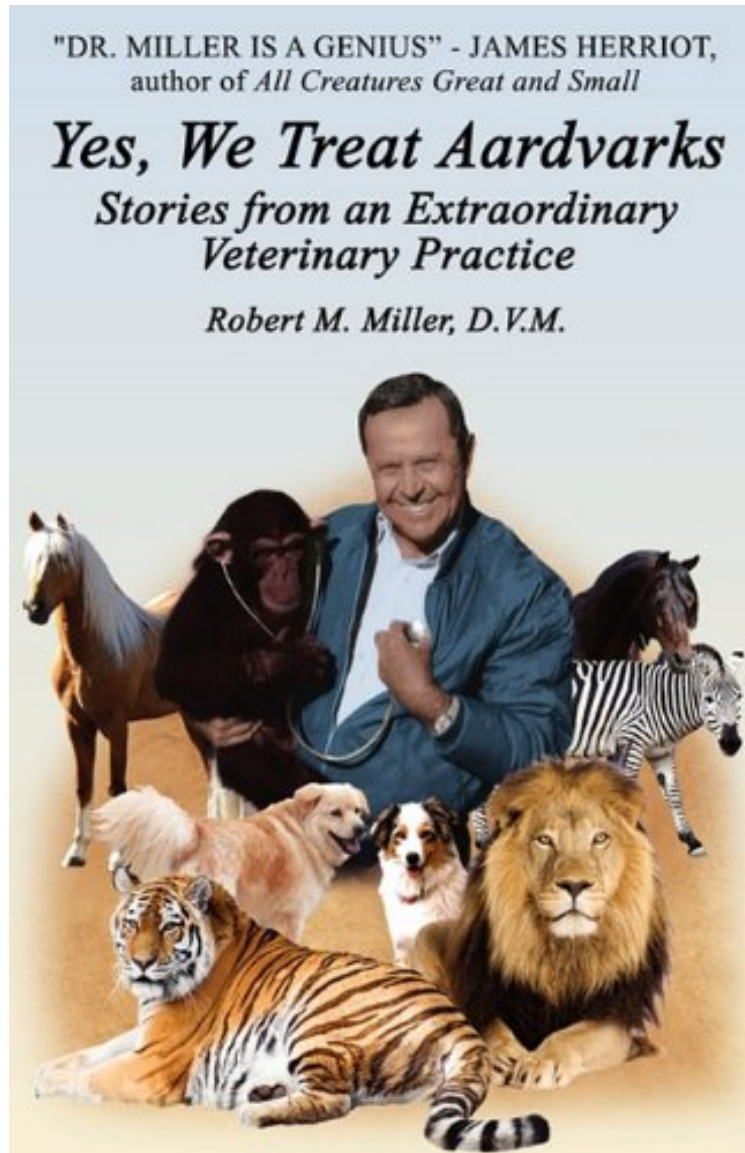

The author apparently produced cartoons for vet journals in addition to his practice, and a number were included in the book. I tried all the font sizes but many of the cartoons did not have captions which were readable. Grumpiness!! Also, in just about every sentence there were hyphenated words that appeared mid-sentence etc and had no obvious purpose. Again, I tried different font sizes thinking that these words were meant to be placed at the end of a sentence.....no success.
