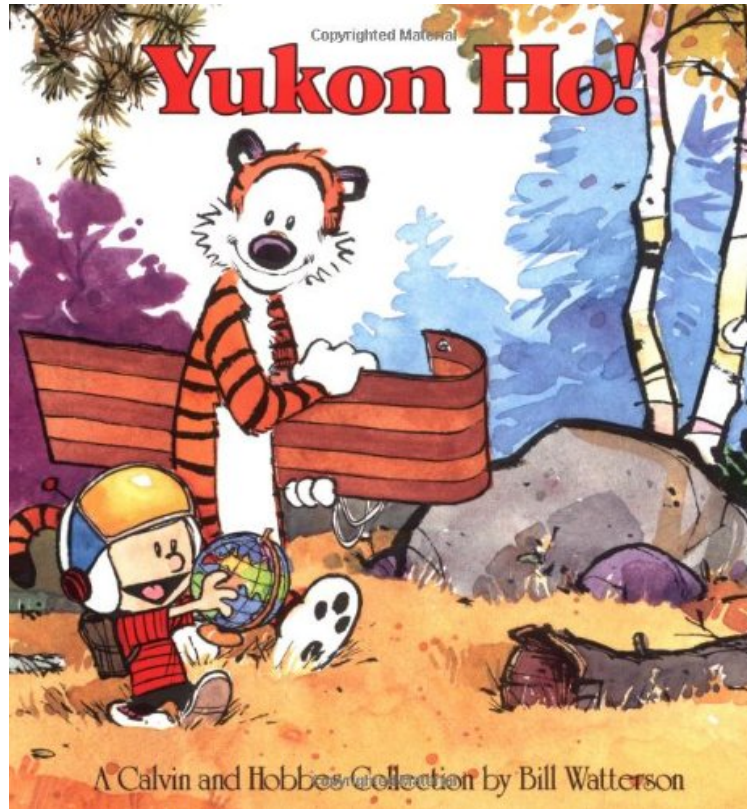

Perhaps I noticed this because I used to work in a book binding shop, but on several of the books the covers were not even glued to the pages; the covers and pages were improperly cut, and unlike quality hardback books, the pages were not stitched but only glued (or not glued) together. Naturally, I wasn't surprised to see that these books were made in China.
